We are so excited to have you come to Our Lady of Guadalupe to help celebrate Catholic Schools week and attend our Special Person's Day mass and lunch.

Arrival: Please arrive at Our Lady of Guadalupe School between 9:30 and 9:40 am.

Parking will be available in the south lot next to the church and the north lots near the parish life center and gym. Street parking is also encouraged on 34th, 35th and other surrounding streets.

Entry: Please enter the school at the main entrance door (up the ramp on Myrtle Street) to be directed to your child's classroom.

Mass: At 9:45am everyone will go to the church (students will sit with their special person for Mass) which will begin at 10am. Bags, purses, jackets may be left in the classroom (which will be locked during mass). After Mass, students and guests return to the classroom for lunch and social time.

Social: In the classroom your student will show you around the classroom & you can share stories over a <u>lunch</u> that the child will provide for you.
