P.O. Meeting Highlights

March

Principal Report

- Financial aid packets went out last Friday
 - Financial aid packets decreased
- Registration is due this Friday
 - Registration fee was raised
- Tuition increase
- Teacher raise was budgeted
- Parish subsidy doesn't cover 100% of the "in-parish" students
- School supplies: Still under discussion
- The only teacher we know for sure that is leaving is Jake Zwaller (5th Grade). He will be missed!
- Thanks to Heather and Courtney for the amazing auction!

Treasurer Report

- Charleston Wrap funds received (\$4,784)
- \$25k payment has been made to the school from PO funds
- Final auction numbers will be available at next month's meeting
- Early indications are that the Parent Organization will be able to meet our \$125k fundraising commitment to the school for the first time in many years!

Old Business

Auction Re-cap- Heather/Courtney

- Numbers are not finalized, but it looks like we've made \$155k gross before expenses (which is \$15 20k more than any of the auctions in the last 5 years)
- Fund a Need far exceeded our target of \$20k
- Most buy-a-spots sold out
- Silent auction raised just short of \$35k
- Bar was fully funded
- Have things to think about for next year
- Sending out a survey requesting feedback and possibly theme ideas
