Principal Report

- Father Kevin has a long recovery ahead of him. His speech is improving. Rehab will start soon and there will be substitute priests in the short term.
- The new pastor and vicar are wonderful, very connected men.
- New school calendar for 2024/25 has been approved and will be up soon. (Sent home in last week's FCE)
- There is a bunch of interest in the school and many tours happening for potential new students.
- Loop the Lupe volunteering has been approved to count towards hours for this school year.

Treasurer Report

- Voted to make a \$100K payment to the school.
- P.O. has officially fully-funded the school with the annual required \$125K payment!
- We also have a healthy P.O. budget to start next year!

New Business

- Loop the Lupe (June 8th):
 - This is the 8th year of this event
 - It is the parish's biggest external annual fundraiser of the year (more than 700 participants last year).
 - This event helps to unify the parish and school.
 - The parish is asking the school to encourage families to participate, volunteer to help and spread the word to other folks in the community.
 - Down the road, the parish is looking for the school to take more ownership of the event and potentially own/mange a portion, like the Beer Garden.
 - A suggestion was made to post the event on the individual classroom FB pages to ensure as many parents as possible are aware.
- Bingo Night (Fri, May 17th, 6-8pm):
 - Will be a fun-raiser, rather than fundraiser this year.
 - \$20 Pay at the Door (School Hall)
 - Cash bake sale/pizza slices and everyone is welcome (all ages).
